I am pleased to present The Catholic Diocese of Madison Foundation's 2015-2016 Annual Report. This is the first-ever annual report from our Catholic Foundation, and certainly marks a moment of growth for The Catholic Diocese of Madison Foundation (CDMF/Foundation) and our diocese. Many of you have given through the Foundation before, when you made a gift to the Priests for Our Future Campaign. The CDMF houses the Priests for Our Future Endowment Fund, as well as 15 additional endowment funds, and two non-endowed funds. At the conclusion of the 2015-2016 fiscal year, the CDMF held just over \$27 million in assets. I am grateful to the CDMF Board of Directors and staff for their work in growing the Foundation for our diocese. Thank you for your generosity and for the support you continue to show the Diocese of Madison and all its worthwhile endeavors.



JOHN J. KARSTEN MEMORIAL ENDOWMENT

John J. Karsten, a 4th degree Knight of Columbus, passed away in February 2016 after living with Duchenne muscular dystrophy since the age of 5. John's parents established the John J. Karsten Memorial Endowment in his honor. This fund provides assistance to people with disabilities and their families in the Platteville parishes, enabling John's spirit of faithfulness and service to continue.





APOSTOLATE TO THE HANDICAPPED ENDOWMENT

Each year the Apostolate to the Handicapped awards grants throughout the diocese to parishes, schools, and programs that minister to and better accommodate people with disabilities. These grants are made possible through the Apostolate to the Handicapped Endowment.

Families with Children with Special Needs (FUNNE) is a program of the Catholic Multicultural Center that offers Spanish-speaking families the tools they need to care for and support their loved ones.

"It is important to those of us who have this challenge to participate in Parish functions in the new hall... the elevator is a Godsend."




FAITHFULLY AND SKILLFULLY CREATE




The Catholic Diocese of Madison Foundation Financial Snapshot
